Police officers acting within the scope of the Program shall be agents of the Attorney General under section 717(1)(f) of the *Criminal Code* (Canada) and section 10(2)(f) of the *Youth Criminal Justice Act* (Canada) and Section 10(2)(f) of the *Youth Justice Act* (Nova Scotia) for the purpose of assessing whether there is sufficient evidence to proceed with the prosecution of the offence when considering a referral to the Restorative Justice Program.

The provisions of this Program shall constitute guidelines pursuant to Section 6(a) of the *Public Prosecution Act* (Nova Scotia).

The Attorney General may, from time to time, establish protocols not inconsistent with the Program for the implementation of the Program.

Police agencies, the Public Prosecution Service, the Public Safety and Security Division, the Correctional Services Division and the Victim Services Unit of the Court Services Division of the Department of Justice, and community agencies as approved by the Department of Justice, may, from time to time, establish internal directives not inconsistent with the programs and protocols referred to above for the implementation of the Program.

All previous Program Authorizations related to the Restorative Justice Program are hereby rescinded.

**Schedule “A”****“Restorative Justice: A Program for Nova Scotia, Department of Justice”**

(Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program for Youth and Adults)

**1. PROGRAM GOALS**

1.1 The Restorative Justice Program is designed to:

- 1.1.1 reduce recidivism - it has been shown that face to face meetings with victims can have a profound effect on the future behaviour of offenders. The nature of the restorative process provides an opportunity to focus on the underlying causes of the criminal behaviour and the constructive reintegration of the offender into the community;
- 1.1.2 increase victim satisfaction - by having a forum in which victims can discuss the impact of the offence and identify the reparative measures to be taken, they will derive greater satisfaction;
- 1.1.3 strengthen communities - by promoting a restorative approach which invites community participation in achieving reconciliation between offenders and those harmed through the commission of an offence;  
and

- 1.1.4 increase public confidence in the justice system - greater participation by communities and victims in community-based restorative justice processes as an alternative or supplement to the formal criminal justice system will enhance public confidence.

## 2. PROGRAM OBJECTIVE

- 2.1. The expanded Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program (NSRJP) will align the provincial alternative measures program for adults (1996 Adult Diversion Program) with the Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program for youth (2003) and the Integrated Adult Restorative Justice Pilot Program (2011) in all communities across the Province. The expanded Program will result in increased access to justice for more Nova Scotians.
- 2.2. Referral of adults for eligible offences as noted in Section 7.2 chart, and who have met the RJ Referral Eligibility criteria, will be managed using a “shared-skills” model in partnership between NSRJP restorative justice agencies and Community Corrections. This collaborative partnership will provide an enhanced level of service to victims, offenders and communities across the province.
- 2.3. The Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program offers to eligible accused persons, victims and the criminal justice system an opportunity to have active involvement in addressing the harm caused by the offence in a manner which is restorative and contributes to healing.
- 2.4. The Restorative Justice Program provides an option, which is transparent, accountable, and accessible to accused persons, victims and the community while repairing, to the extent possible, the harm caused by the offence.
- 2.5. Implementation of a comprehensive, shared-skilled Restorative Justice Program where government and community-based organizations, in partnership, respond to criminal behaviour of both youth and adults, will contribute to “Nova Scotia having a people-centered justice system and the safest communities in the country”.

## 3. PROGRAM AUTHORITY AND STRUCTURE

- 3.1 The Restorative Justice Program is a Program approved by the Attorney General for Nova Scotia, pursuant to s. 717 of the *Criminal Code*, and S. 10 of the *Youth Criminal Justice Act* (YCJA) and is administered by the Nova Scotia Department of Justice.
- 3.2 Police officers acting within the scope of the Program shall be agents of the Attorney General under S. 717(1)(f) of the *Criminal Code* and S. 10(2)(f) of the *Youth Criminal Justice Act* and the *Youth Justice Act* for the purposes of assessing whether there is sufficient evidence to proceed with the prosecution of an offence when considering referral to Restorative Justice.
- 3.3 The Police Cautioning Program set out in this document is approved by the Attorney General for Nova Scotia pursuant to Section 7 of the *Youth Criminal Justice Act* and Section 7 of the *Youth Justice Act*.
- 3.4 The provisions of this Program shall constitute guidelines pursuant to S. 6(a) of the *Public Prosecutions Act*.
- 3.5 Referral can be made to the Restorative Justice Program from four distinct entry points in the Criminal Justice System:
- i) Police Entry Point - pre-charge  
Referral by police officers  
Referral of Level 1 and Level 2 offences
  - ii) Crown Attorney Entry Point - post-charge/pre-conviction  
Referral by Crown attorneys  
Referral of Level 1 and Level 2 offences
  - iii) Court Entry Point - post-conviction/pre-sentence  
Referral by Judges  
Referral of Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3 offences

- iv) Corrections Entry Point - post-sentence  
Referral by Correctional Services/Victim Services Unit staff  
Referral of all levels of offences

#### **4. OPERATIONAL PRINCIPLES**

- 4.1 The Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program in relation to adult referrals, is supported by Correctional Services P&P which relies on restorative principles and processes for referrals managed by probation staff. Referrals managed by the NSRJP agency staff are guided by contracted Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), with associated Protocols and Guiding Restorative Principles. Such contracts are Agreements between the Minister of Justice and the RJ Agencies.
  - 4.2 The Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program in relation to adult referrals, is based on a “shared-skills” model in partnership between Correctional Services, Community Corrections Probation Officers and NSRJP Agency staff.
  - 4.3 The Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program “shared-skills” model used in working with adult referrals involves the following process:
    - 4.3.1 all adult referrals for pre-charge and post-charge will be sent to the local Community Corrections office for the administrative purpose of being entered into JEIN;
    - 4.3.2 the senior probation officer and the RJ agencies will together, process all referrals from the police (pre-charge) or Crown (post-charge) sent for alternative measures for persons age 18 and older;
    - 4.3.3 referrals where it was jointly decided would be managed by Correctional Services will be managed in accordance with Correctional Services P&P which relies on restorative principles and processes;
    - 4.3.4 referrals where it was jointly decided would be managed by the restorative justice agency staff are guided by Protocols and Guiding Restorative Principles, in accordance with and part of a Memorandum of Understanding contractual agreement with the Minister.
  - 4.4 The Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program provides to those accused persons who are eligible, the opportunity to participate in a program of alternative measures, using restorative justice principles, and which is to be undertaken prior to the initiation of any formal Court proceedings. All parties have an opportunity to have their voice heard, needs identified and contribute in a meaningful way in establishing a resolution.
  - 4.5 Participation in the NSRJP will result in a Restorative Justice Agreement based on consensus between those parties involved in the Restorative Justice process which, once successfully completed, will terminate any further criminal proceedings in relation to the particular matter.
  - 4.6 Participation in the NSRJP is to be of a voluntary nature by all eligible (accused, victim, community members and associated support people) for the process.
- #### **5. PROGRAM GUIDELINES FOR POLICE CAUTIONS (YOUTH ONLY)**
- 5.1 Prior to issuing a Police Caution, a police officer shall consider whether taking no further action, giving a verbal warning or, with the consent of the young person, referring the young person to a program or agency in the community would, after taking into consideration the principles in s. 4 of the *Youth Criminal Justice Act* (Canada) and S. 5 of the *Youth Justice Act* (Nova Scotia), be sufficient to deal with the offence.
  - 5.2 Subject to paragraph 5.1, a police officer shall issue a Police Caution in relation to a first-time offender who the police officer believes has committed a Level 1 offence, unless the police officer determines that issuing a Police Caution would be insufficient to deal with the offence after considering the principles set out in s. 4 of the *Youth Criminal Justice Act* (Canada) and S. 5 of the *Youth Justice Act* (Nova Scotia).
  - 5.3 The police officer must have reasonable and probable grounds to believe that the young person has committed an offence prior to issuing a Police Caution.

5.4 Persons who believe that a Police Caution has been inappropriately issued may obtain review of the Caution through relevant administrative procedures applicable to the police agency in question.

**6. DEFINITIONS**

6.1 Terms and Definitions - See attached “Appendix A”

**7. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

7.1 Prior to an accused person becoming involved in the Restorative Justice Program, the following eligibility criteria must be considered and/or satisfied:

- 7.1.1 the decision to proceed by way of Restorative Justice Program is made having regard for the needs of the accused person, the victim and the interests of society;
- 7.1.2 the Attorney General or their agent shall determine if there is sufficient evidence to proceed with the prosecution of the offence and any such prosecution is not in any way barred at law;
- 7.1.3 the accused person accepts responsibility for the act or omission that forms the basis of the offence, which is alleged to have been committed;
- 7.1.4 the accused person, having been informed of the Restorative Justice Program, fully and freely consents to participate in the program, having been given a reasonable opportunity to consult with legal counsel.

## 8. CASE REFERRAL REVIEW

### 8.1 Pre-Charge Referral Process (Referral by Police Officer)

8.1.1 If, after completing the Restorative Justice Program Checklist, a referral to the Restorative Justice Program is considered appropriate, the referring officer shall:

8.1.1.1 ensure that the accused person is aware of their right to legal counsel;

8.1.1.2 send the Restorative Justice Program Checklist to the local Restorative Justice Agency/MLSN if aboriginal (for youth); and

8.1.1.3 send the Restorative Justice Program Checklist to the local Community Corrections Probation Office for adults.

8.1.2 In cases where the Restorative Justice Program personnel deems a referral inconsistent with the eligibility criteria set out in Section 7, they may issue a “Notice of Reconsideration” to the referring officer. Unless otherwise resolved between the Restorative Justice Program personnel and the referring officer, the Restorative Justice Program personnel will close the file associated with the referral 30 days after the release of the “Notice of Reconsideration”.

8.1.2.1 The Restorative Justice Agency will contact the referral agent if the case will take more than 6 months to process.

8.1.3 Where the accused is Aboriginal, and is in agreement with the referral, the referral will be sent to the Mi’kmaw Legal Support Network (MLSN), who will manage all aspects of the case using a customary law approach and will provide the referral Agent with required updates.

### 8.2 Post-charge Referral Process (Referral by Crown Attorney)

8.2.1 If the Crown Attorney considers a referral to the Restorative Justice Program appropriate, the Crown Attorney shall:

8.2.1.1 review the Restorative Justice Program Checklist, as completed by the peace officer;

8.2.1.2 complete the appropriate section on the Restorative Justice Program Checklist; and

8.2.1.3 send the Restorative Justice Program Checklist to the local Restorative Justice Agency/MLSN if aboriginal (for youth); and

8.2.1.4 send the Restorative Justice Program Checklist to the local Community Corrections Probation Office for adults.

8.2.2 In cases where the Restorative Justice Program personnel deems a referral inconsistent with the pre-charge/post-charge eligibility criteria set out in Section 4, they may issue a “Notice of Reconsideration” to the Crown Attorney. Unless otherwise resolved between Restorative Justice Program personnel and the referring Crown Attorney, Restorative Justice personnel will close the file associated with the referral 30 days after the release of the “Notice of Reconsideration”.

8.2.3 Once a referral has been accepted, Restorative Justice Program personnel shall provide a progress report to the referring Crown Attorney regarding the status of the case. The time frame for this report shall be guided by the Crown’s assigned review dates for the referral.

8.2.4 Where the accused is Aboriginal, and is in agreement with the referral, the referral will be sent to the Mi’kmaw Legal Support Network (MLSN), who will manage all aspects of the case using a customary law approach and will provide the referral Agent with required updates.

**9. ASSESSMENT PROCESS (For Adult Referrals only)**

- 9.1 Upon receipt of a Restorative Justice Program Checklist (referral) by Community Corrections, the referral information will be entered on the Justice Enterprise Information Network, a file will be opened and the file referred to a probation officer for further review.
- 9.2 The probation staff will contact the Restorative Justice Agency to review the referral and together make a decision as to whether the referral will be managed by the Restorative Justice Agency or Community Corrections staff.
- 9.3 Where the case will be managed by the Restorative Justice Agency, the probation staff will retrieve from JEIN any information of a prior criminal history and past or current Correctional Services file information which would assist the Restorative Justice Agency in managing the referral, including the probation officer's determination of concerns/risk assessment information.
- 9.4 Upon determination of whether the referral will be managed by Restorative Justice agency personnel or Community Corrections, the file manager will manage the file in accordance with their associated Restorative Justice Policy, Protocol and Guiding Restorative Principles which includes but is not limited to the following requirements:
- 9.4.1 establish contact with the referred person, informing them of the opportunity to participate in the Restorative Justice Program and of their right to retain and consult legal counsel.
  - 9.4.2 where the referred person agrees to participate in the Restorative Justice Program; an intake interview will be conducted to determine the referred person's acceptance into the Program.
  - 9.4.3 Prior to the intake interview, and where appropriate, contact will be established with the victim to determine the victim's interest in participating in a Restorative Justice Process.
  - 9.4.4 Contact will be made with Victim Services to determine whether they have had any contact with the victim.
  - 9.4.5 Where it is determined at the intake interview that the referral is accepted for participation in the Restorative Justice Program the file manager will proceed with arranging the restorative process as outlined in the associated Restorative Justice Policy, Protocols and Guiding Restorative Practices or Correctional Services policy and procedures.

**10. RESTORATIVE JUSTICE PROGRAM AGREEMENT**

- 10.1 A formal Restorative Justice Agreement shall be developed with input from parties present, and other impacted persons who are not present, but have submitted their input in writing to the Restorative Justice personnel ahead of time.
- 10.2 The Restorative Justice Agreement is constructed after all persons present have shared their story and suggesting steps they believe will help in repairing the harm to the victim, community and others negatively impacted; other processes that will support the accused in avoiding criminal involvement in the future.
- 10.3 This Restorative Justice Agreement shall specify the outcomes to be completed, agreed date for completion, and signatures of parties involved signifying their commitment to and support of realizing the agreed upon outcomes.

**11. RANGE OF AGREEMENT MEASURES**

- 11.1 The range of measures which may be employed and set out in the Restorative Justice Agreement include, but are not limited to, the following:
- 11.1.1 community service;
  - 11.1.2 restitution/financial compensation;
  - 11.1.3 personal service for the victim;
  - 11.1.4 specialized education programs;

- 11.1.5 referral for counseling/treatment assessment;
- 11.1.6 charitable donation;
- 11.1.7 letter of apology;
- 11.1.8 essay;
- 11.1.9 no further intervention.

### Appendix A - Terms and Definitions

**Case Management:** A process of managing a referral to the restorative justice program that seeks to: satisfy administrative, policy and protocol requirements of the Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program; identify the needs of participants; coordinate and monitor the participation and satisfaction of participants; assist in organizing appropriate supports and services for participants; and ensure that basic principles and values of restorative justice are expressed through service delivery.

**Community of Harm:** The community that experienced a direct or indirect harm (property destruction, a physical or psychological loss - fear etc.) as the result of the offender's actions.

**Community Representative(s):**

- A member of the Community of Harm (geographical area) who participates in the restorative justice process to express how the offending/harmful behaviour has impacted the community, whose role at a restorative session is to share how the community has been impacted by the harm and to offer practical ways that the harm may be repaired, and indicates how the community may be able to offer support to prevent such harmful behaviour in the future;
- A person who is representative of the community (social, political, cultural, etc.) which represents either the person who has been harmed or the person that has caused the harm;

**Facilitation:** A process of guided discussion and first person story sharing that supports participants in identifying root causes of offending behaviour, identification of needs of victim(s), community and offender(s) with the goal of developing a plan/agreement, which will support reparation of harm and a plan to avoid harmful behavior.

**(Restorative Justice) Facilitator:** A person who is trained in facilitating restorative principles and processes in accordance with the Protocols and Guiding Restorative Practices of the Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program. They understand that repairing relationships are key to repairing harm. They bring together the victim, offender and their families and supporters and community for a discussion about the incident and how the harm can be repaired.

**Notice of Reconsideration:** A formal administrative option used in the case management of a referral to the Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program. The notice, which contains specific information related to the case, is sent to the Referring Authority after a determination is made that the referral is inconsistent with either the mandatory or discretionary factors for referral as outlined in NSRJ Program Protocols, or the referred individual ceases to willing participate. The Restorative Justice Agency awaits the decision of the Referring Authority and closes the file within 15 days after the notice is sent.

**Pre-Session Case Management:** A process of managing a referral to the restorative justice program that seeks to: satisfy administrative, policy, protocol and guideline requirements of the Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program; identification of the needs of all participants (with particular attention to those of the victim, offender and community person(s)); coordinate and monitor the participation and satisfaction of participants; assist in organizing appropriate supports and services for participants; and ensure at all times that restorative principles and values of justice are expressed through service delivery. This process occurs before the Restorative Justice Session and can require considerable time to ensure all session participants are ready and feel it is safe (emotionally) to meet in a group session.

**Post-Session Case Management:** A process of managing a referral to the restorative justice program that seeks to: satisfy administrative, policy, protocol and guideline requirements of the Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program; assist in supporting the agreed upon needs of session participants identified in Pre-Session and during the Conference/Session itself; coordinate and monitor the participation; assist in organizing appropriate supports and services for participants; and ensure that basic principles and values of restorative justice are expressed through service delivery. This process occurs after the Restorative Justice Session and focuses on the compliance of the referred person to the terms of the restorative justice agreement.

**Pre-Charge Referral:** A peace officer determines that a person meets all eligibility criteria for referral to the Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program and forwards the file and the Restorative Justice Checklist to the Restorative Justice Agency (youth) or Community Corrections (adults).

**Post Charge Referral:** A Crown Attorney determines that all eligibility criteria are met for referral to the Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program, reviews and completes the Restorative Justice Checklist as completed by the peace officer and forwards the file and checklist to the Restorative Justice Agency (youth) or Community Corrections (adults).

**Post Finding of Guilt Referral:** The Court, following a finding of guilt, determines that a person meets all eligibility criteria for referral to the Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program and orders an adjournment to allow the Restorative Justice Agency to facilitate a restorative justice process. The Court may provide direction to the Restorative Justice Agency in order to achieve its purpose in making a referral. The options ordered by the court may include: Convening a Restorative Justice Process to develop an Agreement that the offender may complete under the supervision of the Restorative Justice agency or Community Corrections; Convening a case conference to provide input as specified from the court including a formal report to the court in order to assist in a possible decision; and Convening a Sentencing Circle which may be attended and/or chaired by a judge and attended by appropriate officers of the court.

**Post Sentence Referral:** A Probation Officer, Youth Worker, or Victim Services Worker determines that a young person meets all eligibility criteria for referral to the Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program, reviews and completes the Restorative Justice Checklist as completed by the peace officer and forwards the file and checklist to the Restorative Justice Agency.

**Referred Person: (also referred to as offender):** An individual who has been referred to the Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program, who has conveyed their responsibility in having committed a criminal act.

**Referring Authority:** A member of the formal criminal justice system in Nova Scotia eligible to refer an alleged person(s) to the Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program (peace officer, crown attorney, court, probation officer, youth worker, or victim services worker).

**Restorative Justice:** there are multiple definitions of restorative justice; for the purposes of the Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program the following definitions in conjunction with this Program Authorization and associated policies, protocols and Guiding Restorative Principles will inform the understanding of restorative justice for the Program:

- a system of criminal justice that focuses on the rehabilitation of offenders through accountability, recognition of impact of behavior on others, reparation of harm to victims and the community at large;
- a philosophy based on bringing together the victim, the offender, and the community; all having equal parts in repairing the relationships destroyed and harm caused by crime. It is understood that relationships matter and when harmed, must be repaired in order to have safe and “just” communities.

**Restorative Justice Process/Conference:** A restorative justice process is one in which the parties with the most at stake in a particular offence (the victim, the offender, their families, and community members) are supported and voluntarily participate in a discussion about the causes, circumstances and impact of the offence. These discussions take place with the assistance of fair and impartial facilitators who are trained in facilitating restorative principles and processes in accordance with the Protocols and Guiding Restorative Practices of the Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program (NSRJP). The purpose is to understand the causes of the crime and its effects on those who have been harmed, and address their needs for healing and reparation.

Restorative Justice Conference/Process can mean any of the following:

- **Accountability Conference:** a process where the offender is required to explore the offence and its impact on others who have been impacted, with the guidance of facilitators trained in the Guiding Restorative Principles and Protocols of the NSRJP and develops and commits to a reparation plan which forms the terms of the Restorative Justice Agreement. In attendance are: offender(s); Parent/guardian/supporting adult (for youth referrals); other support person(s) (where relevant), victim (where agreeable) and facilitator(s)/probation officer(s).
- **Community Conference/Circle:** a session/conference/circle facilitated in accordance with the Guiding Restorative Principles and Protocols of the NSRJP. A larger group of participants are engaged: including the offender, support persons, victims, secondary victims, victim support persons, relevant professionals, community representatives and facilitators trained in the Guiding Restorative Principles and Protocols of the NSRJP. The process is dialogue-driven providing all participants the opportunity to talk, ask questions and to have input into

the reparation plan, which will form the Restorative Justice Agreement. Focus is placed on the criminal/harming behavior (past harm); the impact it has had, and what needs to happen to heal the harm (present effects); and creating a plan to avoid future harmful behavior (future outcomes).

- **Group Accountability Conference/Session:** A session/conference facilitated in accordance with the Protocols and Guiding Restorative Practices of the Nova Scotia Restorative Justice Program. Offenders referred to the Restorative Justice Program (referee(s)) meet as a group with trained facilitators to participate in an educational workshop. Workshops may conclude with the person's commitment to a reparation plan which forms the Restorative Justice Agreement. In attendance are 2 or more offenders, facilitator(s), community resource presenters (such as Al-Anon, Corporate victim, etc.).
- **Mi'kmaq Justice Circles** - referrals from the police or Crown Attorney. Participants may include an Elder, the victim(s), family and community working together with the offender to find ways of holding them accountable. An agreement on how the offender can make amends for their behaviour is created.
- **Victim-Offender Conference:** - the emphasis is on victim healing, offender accountability, and restoration of losses. Facilitators trained in the NSRJ P Guiding Principles and Protocols ensure a safe environment for the victim and offender to meet. The process is dialogue-driven allowing the victim to describe how the crime affected them and receive answers to questions they may have. The offender has the opportunity to take direct responsibility for his or her behavior, learn the full impact of what they did, and be part of developing a plan for making amends to the person(s) they harmed. This type of conference is typically used with property related offenses.

**Victim/Person Harmed:** an individual, group of individuals, organization or other such entity whereby persons who are affiliated with, have suffered some form of loss as a result of a criminal act. Loss can include physical loss of property, as well as emotional loss such as one's sense of safety. The definition is both narrow and broad so as to include those who are clearly identifiable as being impacted as well as the broader community, which also is impacted by criminal behavior. Every criminal act has resulting harmful impact.
