

WILDLIFE COMPENSATION VALUES 2024

This program compensates **registered Nova Scotia Farms** (Registered under the Nova Scotia Farm Registration Act) who experience damage to specified Agriculture products caused by specific wildlife species. Farmers must notify the Commission as soon as possible and not later than **72 hours** after the damage has occurred. The cause or probable cause of loss or death must be confirmed by the Commission.

CROP DAMAGE

Compensation may be paid for damage to the following eligible crops:
