Responsibilities also include overseeing the development of the province's short and long-term revenue and economic forecasts, the development and management of economic and social statistics data bases for use by government in public policy development, ensuring the effective administration of provincial tax credit programs and the overall effective operation of the branch.

You have a university degree in a relevant discipline plus several years of public sector experience in a management and/or legal environment. Masters degrees in economics, business, management, or public administration would be an asset. Significant experience in fiscal and economic policy, coordination, and assessment as well as extensive experience in conducting research and analysis and in-depth knowledge of the public sector are essential. In addition to strong management and leadership skills you will possess effective motivational, organizational and communication skills with the ability to deliver services in a high pressure environment often with time constraints. Strong technical experience in PC based applications is essential.
