Mechanic II (Antigonish)

Under the general supervision of the Fleet Service Coordinator, the Mechanic diagnoses equipment failure, repairs, rebuilds and makes adjustments to a variety of government mobile machinery and equipment.

Must have completed Grade 12 or acceptable equivalent. A Provincial Certificate of Qualification in the Bus and Transport Mechanic Trade is required. Provincial Certificates of Qualification in (Heavy Duty) Equipment, or Air Conditioning Certification would be considered assets. A knowledge of computer controlled engine diagnostic technology and competency would be considered an asset. The successful completion of training and knowledge of the Occupational Health and Safety Act, First Aid and WHMIS would also be considered assets.
