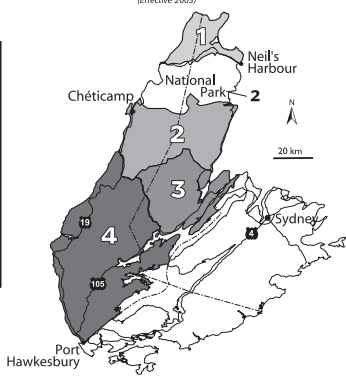

How To Apply

Step 1 BEFORE YOU CALL

- Decide when you want to hunt
 - Season 1: September 29 to October 4
 - Season 2: October 6 to October 11
 - Season 3: December 9 to December 11 (*Zone 1 only*)
- Decide where you want to hunt (*see map*). For legal description of zones visit the website.
- 2007 Moose Harvest success rate statistics are available on the website.
- Have your Wildlife Resources Card in hand.

Step 2 CALL 1-900-565-3337 TO APPLY

This is not an information line. You will be charged \$6 (*plus tax*) every time this number is called. The charge will be billed to the phone used to make the call. Charges cannot be billed to another number. You cannot apply using a cell phone. You may apply only once. If you have questions about the draw, contact your local DNR office before you call the application line.

Step 3 PUBLIC DRAW

DATE: Tuesday, June 17 at 11:00 am
LOCATION: St. Peter's Lions Hall, St. Peter's, Richmond County, NS

Step 4 DRAW RESULTS

After June 17, visit the website to check the status of your application. Winners' names will only be announced at the draw. Winners will be notified by mail.
