The Construction Manager is responsible for the administration and direction of all major capital bridge and highway projects and assigned construction work within the District. Ensures location surveys, designs and cost estimates are economical and feasible, specifications are adhered to and projects meet high quality standards within budget and scheduling objectives. The Construction Manager is also responsible for preparing the construction budget by evaluating the condition of highway infrastructure, developing rehabilitative and new construction strategies and monitoring ongoing expenditures of a large number of high value projects throughout the District.

Bachelor's Degree in Engineering and eligibility for membership in APENS. Candidates for this position must have a minimum of five(5) years of progressive Supervisory experience along with technical and practical knowledge of all matters related to road/bridge construction and rehabilitation. S/he will have strong leadership qualities including problem-solving and decision-making skills, planning and organizational skills, excellent communications skills, strong public relations skills and an understanding of the principles of project management as it relates to highway and bridge construction and maintenance. The Manager must also have a working knowledge of the Occupational Health and Safety Act, financial skills to manage budgets and excellent Human Resource skills.
