Under the general direction of the Operations Supervisor, the student labourer will be assigned tasks related to highway construction and maintenance activities. These activities could include traffic control, manual brush cutting, painting, litter pickup, general building and yard maintenance, installing culverts, road surface maintenance and installation of guardrails.

A student is considered a person studying at a high school, community college, university or other place of higher education and who will be returning to school in the fall.

The students must be able to work with limited supervision and demonstrate good judgement. Training in Temporary Workplace Signing Accreditation, Traffic Control Person Accreditation, Transportation of Dangerous Goods, and WHMIS would be considered an asset, as well as a valid driver's license with a good driving record.
