Mechanic Apprentice

Western District - Bridgewater Mechanical Branch



This position is under the general supervision of the Fleet Service Coordinator and is located in the Western District at the Mechanical Branch in Bridgewater.

The apprentice will be required to supply tools suitable for their work. The wage rate will be prorated using the Department's journeymen rate of \$22.24 in accordance with the recognized percentage scale prescribed in the Apprenticeship Agreement.

Grade 12 is required plus successful completion of a second (2nd) year course in Truck and Transport Repair with a minimum of 1500 hours credited to his/her apprenticeship. Work experience related to the trade plus other trades training, including the operation of heavy trucks and equipment, would be considered an asset.
