This Fall, eligible resident hunters will have the opportunity to hunt antlerless deer in one of four zones in Nova Scotia. 11,900 Antlerless Deer Hunting Stamps are available within zones 1, 2, 2A and 4 through a random draw.

Applications will be accepted 24 hours a day from 7:00 am, July 19, to midnight August 29, 2008. Apply by phone or online.

HOW TO APPLY:

1. Choose where you want to hunt by selecting a Deer Management Zone.
2. Have your Wildlife Resources Card in hand.
3. Apply by phone or online:
 - Call 1-900-565-3337. Calls cannot be made using a cell phone.
 - Apply Online at www.gov.ns.ca/natr/draws/deerdraw

There is a non-refundable application fee of \$6.11 + HST. You may apply only once.

DRAW RESULTS: A computerized, random draw will occur on August 30, 2008. Winners will be notified by mail. Applicants can check their individual draw results:

- a) By calling 1-877-535-1234 or 493-1412 from September 6 - 12th.
- b) Online at www.gov.ns.ca/natr/draws/deerdraw – beginning September 2nd at noon.

REMINDERS:

1. Applicants must be eligible to hold a 2008 Resident Deer Hunting Licence.
2. You may apply only once.
3. Holders of an Antlerless Deer Hunting Stamp for zone 2 may also hunt antlerless deer in zone 2A.
4. Antlerless Deer Hunting Stamps are not transferrable or refundable.

NOTE: There may be special regulations relative to 2008 harvest of antlerless deer in zone 2A, pending proposed regulation change approval. Check the 2008 Hunting and Fur Harvesting Licence and Summary of Regulations booklet or online at www.gov.ns.ca/natr/draws/deerdraw in the following weeks.
