The successful candidates will be assigned Division Crewperson duties, including a combination of: traffic control, manual brush cutting, painting, general maintenance, installing culverts, road surface maintenance and installation of guardrails.

The qualifications for this position include Grade 10 plus one year related experience or an acceptable equivalent. The ability to work with limited supervision, demonstrate good judgement and initiative are essential. The successful candidate must be able to complete department documents. The ability to operate small power tools and portable equipment, Temporary Workplace Signing Accreditation, Traffic Control Person Accreditation, Transportation of Dangerous Goods, and a Class III Nova Scotia Driver's license with air brake endorsement would be considered assets.

The successful candidates may also be required to perform the duties of other job positions as outlined in Group 1 of the CUPE collective agreement, for which they are qualified. Applicants with a current length of service with the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal will have preference over other applicants, as per the existing CUPE Union Agreement.
