

NOTICE OF PURCHASE

THENCE N 34 degrees, 30 minutes W, 25 chains (502.9 metres) along a southwestern boundary of Grant No. 17965 to The Cumberland Railway and Coal Company Limited to a southeastern boundary of The Cumberland Railway and Coal Company Limited, being the northern corner of the herein described lands, being Grant No. 11396 to James E. Hannan and Thomas King;

THENCE S 53 degrees, 30 minutes W, 40 chains (804.7 metres) along a southeastern boundary of The Cumberland Railway and Coal Company Limited to a northeastern boundary of The Cumberland Railway and Coal Company Limited, being the western corner of the herein described lands, being Grant No. 11396 to James E. Hannan and Thomas King;

THENCE S 34 degrees, 30 minutes E, 25 chains (502.9 metres) along a portion of the northeastern boundary of Grant No. 17965 to The Cumberland Railway and Coal Company Limited to the northwestern boundary of Grant No. 9423 to George D. Hewson and George King, being the southern corner of the herein described lands, being Grant No. 11396 to James E. Hannan and Thomas King;

THENCE N 53 degrees, 30 minutes E, 40 chains (804.7 metres) along a portion of the northwestern boundary of Grant No. 9423 to George D. Hewson and George King to the **PLACE OF BEGINNING**.
