Duties

Under the direction of the Director of Strategic Policy Planning and Services (SPPS), this position manages the regulatory innovation group within the division.

Responsibilities include the management of the department's relationships with Offshore Accord partners on regulatory matters including the development of a new modern framework for offshore regulations as well as development of new regulations and legislative changes for occupational health and safety. They also include the coordination of departmental initiatives on new legislation and regulation as part of the Province's Better Regulation initiative.

The manager represents the province at intergovernmental, interdepartmental and stakeholder meetings and must be familiar with trends in regulatory policy in general and public interest regulation for health, safety, environment, resource conservation and economic regulation.

Qualifications

Minimum of five years related experience and a bachelor's degree in Law, Masters degree in Public Administration (MPA) or Masters in Business Administration (MBA).

Experience in an energy related field and with significant familiarity with policy development and current policy issues in energy and related areas.
