Pursuant to section 9 of the said Act, Nova Scotia Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal has deposited with the Minister of Transport, and in the office of the Registry of Deeds, located at the Land Registration Office, 375 Main Street, in Port Hood, Inverness County, under deposit number 91377680 a description of the following work, its site and plans:

McArthurs Bridge Replacement, located on River Inhabitants Road over MacMasters Brook near Princeville, Inverness County.
