*You are hereby notified that:*

1. The land and building located at Pereau Road, Pereau, in the County of Kings, Province of Nova Scotia, commonly referred to as the "Dimock House," being that lot of land recorded at the Registry of Deeds Office at Kentville, in the County of Kings, in Book Number 729 at Pages 436 on March 11, 1988 and more fully described in the Schedule "A" attached hereto has been recommended for deregistration from the Provincial Registry of Heritage Property.

2. The reasons for this proposed deregistration are: the structure's state of deterioration.

3. The effect of deregistration from the Provincial Registry of Heritage Property means that the lands and buildings described herein will cease to be a Provincial Heritage Property and the owner may alter or demolish said property without reference, under the Heritage Property Act, to the Governor-in-Council.

4. A decision with respect to deregistration of the property herein described from the Provincial Registry of Heritage Property will not take place until 30 days after service of this Notice in order to allow adequate time for interested persons to make representation to the Minister with respect to the proposed deregistration. You are invited to forward to me at 1747 Summer Street, Halifax, Nova Scotia, B3H 3A6, any comments you might wish to make on this matter during the 30 day period.
