The Canada-Nova Scotia Infrastructure Secretariat administers the federal-provincial agreements that provide funding to municipal infrastructure projects in Nova Scotia. The Secretariat helps communities access programs to improve their infrastructure – contributing to healthy, vibrant, sustainable communities. Under the general direction of the Manager of Client Services, the Senior Municipal Engineer provides technical advice and expertise in the area of civil engineering. The successful candidate will establish engineering standards, criteria and procedures for federal-provincial capital funding programs for municipal infrastructure projects. He/she assists senior management with infrastructure planning and policy, and evaluates infrastructure project applications. He/she monitors approved projects to ensure compliance with the terms of the funding agreement.

The successful candidate will have a Bachelor of Civil Engineering plus 6 years experience in the field of Municipal Engineering (pollution abatement; water supply, distribution and treatment; solid waste management; transportation; and buildings). The successful candidate must be a member in good standing or eligible for membership in the Association of Professional Engineers of Nova Scotia (APENS). The successful candidate must have strong communication skills and a high level of proficiency in the use of standard computer-based database management and spreadsheet software. Knowledge of the provincial environmental regulations, provincial procurement policy, the Municipal Government Act and public transportation policy is an asset.
