

Christmas Fire Safety Message

The Nova Scotia Fire Service reminds you to please keep fire safety in mind over the holiday season.

To ensure you and your family remain safe from fire:

- Take care when cooking or smoking while under the influence of alcohol.
- Never discard fireplace or wood stove ashes in your green bin! Instead, place them in a metal container, outside and away from your home. Ensure the ashes have been completely extinguished before disposing.
- Never leave candles unattended. Keep out of reach of children and pets and place in a sturdy container. As a safe and convenient alternative, try battery operated candles and lights.
- Remember to water your natural tree, turn out the lights when not in use, and keep it away from heaters or any flammable objects.
