We are seeking applications from individuals interested in serving on the volunteer Board of Directors for the South West Nova District Health Authority.

The health authority governs, manages, plans, delivers, monitors and evaluates health services for residents of Shelburne, Yarmouth and Digby Counties. Facilities and services include Yarmouth Regional Hospital, Roseway Hospital and Digby General Hospital, Public Health, Mental Health and Addiction Services.

Board appointments are selected through two separate processes. One-third of the members are appointed directly by the Minister of Health. Two-thirds are appointed by the Minister from a list of names submitted by the health authority's nominating committee, comprising local individuals representing the district's four Community Health Boards (CHBs).

- ◆ Three CHB-nominated positions
