We are seeking applications from individuals interested in serving on the volunteer Board of Directors for the Pictou County Health Authority.

The Pictou County Health Authority is responsible for delivering health care services to the 48,000 residents of Pictou County as well as regional programs to the larger population of northeastern Nova Scotia. We deliver this care through the Aberdeen Hospital in New Glasgow, Sutherland Harris Memorial Hospital in Pictou, Addiction Services, Mental Health Services, Primary Health Care and Public Health Services.

Board appointments are selected through two separate processes. One-third of the members are appointed directly by the Minister of Health. Two-thirds are appointed by the Minister from a list of names submitted by the health authority's nominating committee, comprising local individuals representing the district's two Community Health Boards (CHBs).

Upcoming vacancies include:

- ◆ Two ministerial appointments from throughout the district
- ◆ Three CHB-nominated positions from the catchment areas of Pictou West and Central and East Pictou Community Health Boards
