Justices of the Peace

The Department of Justice, Court Services Division, is seeking Administrative Justices of the Peace for the counties of **Lunenburg** and **Queens** and the **Halifax Regional Municipality**.

Duties: An Administrative Justice of the Peace performs the duties defined by the Justice of the Peace Act and Regulations. The primary responsibilities of an Administrative Justice of the Peace is to perform civil weddings under the Solemnization of Marriage Act. There is no remuneration except as prescribed under the Costs and Fees Act and whatever arrangement is made by the Justice of the Peace with the couple being married.

Qualifications: The minimum requirements for an Administrative Justice of the Peace include good standing in the community, no criminal record and a good financial history. Fluency in French will be an asset.
