<b>Pneumococcal Conj.</b> Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine		✓
<b>MMR</b> Measles, mumps and rubella vaccine (2 doses for those born in 1970 or later) See the <a href="#">NS Vaccine Publicly Funded Eligibility Policy</a> for additional eligibility.	✓	

\* Regardless of age, Tdap should be offered with every pregnancy.

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
