Navigating to System for Outbreak and Level of Activity Reporting

1. After logging into CNPHI (https://www.cnphi-rcrsp.ca/cnphi/faces/login.xhtml?lang=en&src=CNPHI) click on the Surveillance tab in the menu:




2. Choose System for Outbreak and Level of Activity Reporting (SOLAR) from the dropdown menu:



Entering a Sub-Regional Report






Entering a Regional Report

Creating a regional report after sub-regional data has been entered:


1. From the SOLAR Dashboard, choose Regional Reports from the Menu:




2. Select the appropriate zone from the drop-down menu:
