LEGIONELLOSIS

Case Definition

Confirmed Case:

Clinical illness with laboratory confirmation of infection:

• Isolation of *Legionella* species or detection of the antigen from respiratory secretions, lung tissue, pleural fluid, or other normally sterile fluids.

OR

• A significant (e.g. fourfold or greater) rise in *Legionella* species IgG titre between acute and convalescent sera.

OR

IgG titre > 1:128 against Legionella species.

OR

• Demonstration of *L. pneumophila* antigen in urine.

Probable Case:

Clinical illness with demonstration of Legionella species DNA.

Clinical Evidence

Comprises two distinct illnesses:

- 1. Legionnaire's disease, characterized by fever, myalgia, cough and pneumonia.
- 2. Pontiac fever, a milder illness without pneumonia.

Reporting Requirements

Report confirmed or probable cases to DHW Surveillance Team via Panorama.
