

PNEUMOCOCCAL DISEASE, INVASIVE

Case Definition

Confirmed Case:

Clinical evidence of invasive disease (see Clinical Evidence) with laboratory confirmation of infection:

- Isolation of *Streptococcus pneumoniae* from a normally sterile site (excluding the middle ear and pleural cavity).
- OR**
- Demonstration of *S. pneumoniae* DNA from a normally sterile site (excluding the middle ear and pleural cavity).

Clinical Evidence

Clinical evidence associated with invasive disease manifests itself mainly as pneumonia with bacteremia, bacteremia without a known site of infection, and meningitis. Pneumonia without bacteremia is not notifiable.

Reporting Requirements

- Report confirmed or probable cases to DHW Surveillance Team via Panorama.
