WAGE CHANGE

Economic and Rural Development acknowledges that post-secondary students now have many choices for jobs. There are more job choices than students available to fill the positions in their field of study.

We are encouraging students to remain in Nova Scotia by increasing the lowest wage we will accept on applications for 2009 to the following:

COOPERATIVE EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

Employer to pay student at least \$12.00 per hour plus 4% vacation pay

NSED is increasing hourly reimbursement for not-for-profit organizations to \$8.00 per hour

Government-funded hourly reimbursement remains at 50% of wage to maximum of \$7.00 per hour

Submission deadline for applications is September 11, 2009.
