

Board Selection Criteria

Agency, Board or Commission		Acadia University Foundation
1	Statute	C. 8, S. 3(1) of Statutes of Nova Scotia 1991, the University Foundations Act
2	Purpose	The Foundation was established as a corporation in 1993 under the University Foundations Act. Its purpose is to develop public knowledge and awareness of Acadia University, and to encourage financial support for the University and its programs.
3	Functions	The Foundation may determine the manner in which the funds available shall be used and distributed for the benefit of Acadia University, and in so determining, be governed by provisions of any bequest or trust or any conditions to which a transfer is made pursuant to the University Foundations Act.
4	Composition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 3 members appointed by the Governor in Council - 2 members appointed by the Governor in Council from a list of 5 persons who are members of, and are nominated by, that body of persons who have the management and control of the affairs of the designated university for which the foundation is established or who constitute the designated university.
5	Formal Qualifications	Two members are Board of Governors members.
6	Work & Experience Requirements	
7	Skills Required	Ability to commit time and effort to the work of the Foundation and Acadia University, including fundraising and external representation. Should have experience with fundraising, organizational management, community-related organizations, or investment management; have a special interest in the university and the university community.
8	Statutory Nomination Requirements	Section 5 (1) (b) Two members appointed from a list of five persons who are members of, and are nominated by, that body of persons who have the management and control of the affairs of the designated university for which the foundation is established or who constitute the designated

9	Term of Appointment	determined by Governor in Council; may be reappointed; cannot serve more than 6 consecutive years
10	Remuneration	expenses only
11	Anticipated Time Commitments	no less than two meetings per year
