1	Statute	C. 390, RSNS, 1989, the <i>Registered Barbers Act</i>
2	Purpose	<p>MINISTERIAL BOARD</p> <p>To examine such persons as from time to time apply to be examined and registered as apprentices or barbers pursuant to this Act. The Board of Examiners shall have the power to examine such candidates, and upon their report to the Council that any candidate has passed the prescribed examinations, the Registrar shall sign and issue the requisite certificate.</p>
3	Functions	
4	Composition	<p>At least one half of the Board of Examiners shall be appointed by the Minister and the remainder by the Council.</p> <p>Total number of appointments determined by by-laws.</p>
5	Formal Qualifications	Must be a registered practising barber for a minimum of 10 years.
6	Work & Experience Requirements	Formal requirements as set out above.
7	Skills Required	Must have practised barbering for at least ten years. Knowledge and ability to examine persons who apply as apprentices or barbers under the <i>Registered Barbers Act</i> . Knowledge and ability to inspect barber shops.
8	Statutory Nomination Requirements	See “Composition” above.

9	Term of Appointment	Three years ss 16(3)
10	Remuneration	\$2.00 for every person examined, paid by the Provincial Council + expenses
11	Anticipated Time Commitments	At least twice every year
12	Other Notes	Due notice of examinations shall be given by advertisement in one or more public newspapers in the City of Halifax.
