

Board Selection Criteria

Agency, Board or Commission		Board of Examiners under the Scalers Act
1	Statute	Chapter 11 of the Acts 2001, the Scalers Act
2	Purpose	To prescribe the qualifications of candidates for licenses as scalers and shall perform such other duties as the Governor in Council may from time to time prescribe including recommending candidates for licenses as scalers.
3	Functions	To approve candidates for the issuing of Scaler's licenses and address other matters regarding scaling as the need arises.
4	Composition	Consists of the following 3 Governor in Council appointments: - 1 member from the sawmill sector - 1 member from the pulpwood sector - 1 member from the small private land tenure Also: - 1 member from Department of Natural Resources (also acts as Chair) The Supervisor of Scaling and another department member shall act as advisors to the Board.
5	Formal Qualifications	Not required but recommend that member be a licensed scaler.
6	Work & Experience Requirements	Must have at least 5 years experience in scaling and must be able to represent the interests of the specific industry sector represented.
7	Skills Required	Must be knowledgeable about the mathematics of wood measurement and Scaling.
8	Statutory/Traditional Nomination Requirements	None
9	Term of Appointment	At the discretion of the Minister.
10	Remuneration	Chair and members: \$75.00 per meeting + expenses (maximum of 5 days/year) No remuneration for departmental representatives.
11	Anticipated Time Commitments	Meet 1-2 times per year in Truro; morning meetings.
12	Other Notes	New Scalers Act passed by Legislative Assembly in 2001 and proclaimed on October 30 th , 2007.
