2	Purpose	To govern, control and administer the affairs of the College of Occupational Therapists; set qualifications for admission; prescribe exams to applicants for admission; disciplining of members; fixing of fees; suspension of practitioners; for the investigation of complaints; making of by-laws, rules and regulations, subject to the approval of the Governor in Council.

4	Composition	Composed of: 4 members of the College elected in the manner provided by the Act; 3 persons appointed by the Governor in Council who are not members of the college Board elects Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary and Treasurer
