1	Statute	C. 69, RSNS, 1989, the Chiropractic Act; former act repealed by C. 4 of Acts of 1999, the Chiropractic Act
2	Purpose	To govern, control and administer the affairs of the Nova Scotia College of Chiropractors; make regulations.
3	Functions	
4	Composition	Composed of: - 6 members of the College (elected); - Registrar (elected); - immediate past-Chair of the Board; 2 persons appointed by Governor in Council (provided they are not members of the College and have shown interest in serving on the board). The Board shall elect annually from its members: Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary and Treasurer
5	Formal Qualifications	2 persons appointed by the Governor in Council shall not be members of the College and have shown an interest in serving on the Board.

8	Statutory Requirements	2 (Governor in Council) members shall not be members of the Nova Scotia College of Chiropractors
