1	Statute	C. 8 of the Acts of 2000, the Medical Laboratory Technology Act
2	Purpose	Regulate the practice of medical laboratory technology and govern its members in accordance with the Act and regulations; establish, maintain and develop standards of knowledge, skills, professional ethics among members; establish, maintain and develop standards of qualification and practice of medical laboratory technologists; establish, maintain and develop standards of continuing education for its members
3	Functions	
4	Composition	The Board consists of 7 members of the College elected as provided in the Act and Regulations + 3 Governor in Council appointments which consist of persons who are not members of the College and having shown an interest in serving. The board shall elect annually: a Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary and Treasurer to constitute an Executive Committee.

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9	Term of Appointment	2 year term (except for initial appointment) may be reappointed
