1	Statute	C. 8, S. 3(1) of Statutes of Nova Scotia 1991, the University Foundations Act
2	Purpose	Provide financial support to the university; develop, foster and encourage public knowledge and awareness of the university and the benefits to the people of the Province; encourage, facilitate and carry out programs and activities that will directly or indirectly increase the financial support of, or confer a benefit on, the foundation for support of the designated university for which the foundation was established and programs in which the designated university is involved; receive, manage and invest funds and property of every nature and kind from any source for the establishment, operation and maintenance of the foundation.

4	Composition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 3 members appointed by the Governor in Council - 2 members appointed by the Governor in Council from a list of 5 persons who are members of, and are nominated by, that body of persons who have the management and control of the affairs of the designated university for which the foundation is established or who constitute the designated university.

7	Skills Required	Should have experience with fundraising, organizational management, community-related organizations, or investment management; have a special interest in the university and the university community.

9	Term of Appointment	determined by Governor in Council; may be reappointed; cannot serve more than 6 consecutive terms.
10	Remuneration	expenses only
11	Anticipated Time Commitments	no less than two meetings per year
