2	Purpose	Govern, control and administer the affairs of the College.

4	Composition	<p>The Board consists of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 8 members of the College elected in the manner provided by this Act; - 1 member of the College appointed by the Dean of the Medical School of Dalhousie University - 1 member of the College appointed by the Society at a general meeting; and - 5 persons appointed by Governor in Council, all of whom are persons who are not members of the College and have shown an interest in serving on the Council.

7	Skills Required	The 5 Governor in Council appointees must not be members of the College but show an interest in serving on the Council.

10	Remuneration	Members: \$500.00/day for orientation \$100.00/hour committee meeting \$1,000.00/day investigation committee + expenses for out-of-town members
