

## Board Selection Criteria

1	Statute	C. 127 of RSNS, 1989, the Denturist Act; repealed by C. 25 of Acts of 2000, the Denturists Act
2	Purpose	Conduct the hearings and proceedings advancing its objects and interests of the profession of denturism (as set out in subsection 5(3); to review the operation of the Act and the regulations and make recommendations to the Minister; to perform other duties as are assigned to it by the Act or the regulations.
3	Functions	
4	Composition	Composed of: 7 members appointed by Governor in Council: four shall be denturists and three shall not be denturists (2 of the denturists appointed shall be the President and Vice President of the Denturist Society of Nova Scotia unless they choose not to accept the appointment); Board designates a member, other than a denturist, to be Chairman of the Board.
