

## Board Selection Criteria

Agency, Board or Commission		Kings Regional Rehabilitation Centre - Board of Management
1	Statute	C. 16, Acts of 1990, the Kings Regional Rehabilitation Act
2	Purpose	To oversee the management and operation of the Kings Regional Rehabilitation Centre.
3	Functions	The Board of Management exercises such powers as are necessary in attaining it's objective. These powers include making by-laws, rules, and regulations; acquisition management and subsequent disposition of real property; construction and maintenance of buildings on such real property; borrowing, with the consent of the Municipality, sums of money upon such terms and conditions as the Board determines.
4	Composition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 4 Governor in Council members</li> <li>- 6 members appointed by the Municipality</li> </ul>
5	Formal Qualifications	Board members must have a basic knowledge and understanding of the role of the function of the Kings Regional Rehabilitation Centre.
6	Work & Experience Requirements	Background or interest in the development and delivery of services to the mentally challenged and persons with mental/physical disabilities.
7	Skills Required	<p>Training, expertise and/or experience in one or more of the following areas would be helpful:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- social sciences and/or interest in the needs of persons who are disabled;</li> <li>- experience in financial/accounting affairs;</li> <li>- experience in engineering/architectural/real estate matters;</li> <li>- legal affairs.</li> </ul>

9	Term of Appointment	Normally for a term of three years; may be reappointed.
10	Remuneration	Chair and Members: Stipend of \$1,800.00/year
11	Anticipated Time Commitments	There are 10 regular board meetings/year for two hours each; daytime. May be special Board meetings from time to time, as required. Board of Management meetings are held in Waterville, Kings County.
