

Board Selection Criteria

Agency, Board or Commission		Annapolis Valley Library Board
1	Statute	C. 254, RSNS 1989, the Libraries Act
2	Purpose	To set policy and provide for the operation of the Annapolis Valley Regional Library, serving the towns of Annapolis Royal, Berwick, Bridgetown, Hantsport, Kentville, Middleton, Windsor and Wolfville, to the Municipalities of Annapolis, Kings and the District of West Hants. A regional library board is a body corporate.
3	Functions	
4	Composition	1 member appointed by each city, town and municipality that is a party to the agreement; 2 members appointed by the Governor in Council; additional members appointed in such manner and number as the parties to the agreement agree.
5	Formal Qualifications	
6	Work & Experience Requirements	
7	Skills Required	Skills in the areas of fundraising, community development, communications, public relations, finance, planning and policy development, and information technology. Must reside in area served by the board; demonstrated interest in libraries.
8	Statutory/Traditional Nomination Requirements	
9	Term of Appointment	Terms for one, two or three years (as determined by the city, town or municipality making the appointment; GIC appointment term is determined by the Governor in Council.
10	Remuneration	No remuneration for serving on this board. Members are reimbursed for mileage.
11	Anticipated Time Commitments	Meetings held minimum of 5 times yearly, Thursday evenings, in various locations within the area served by the board.
12	Other Notes
