1	Statute	C. 254, RSNS 1989, the <i>Libraries Act</i>
2	Purpose	To set policy and provide for the operation of the Halifax Regional Library serving the Halifax Regional Municipality. A regional library board is a body corporate.
3	Functions	
4	Composition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1 member appointed by each city, town and municipality that is a party to the agreement; - 2 members appointed by the Governor in Council; - additional members appointed in such manner and number as the parties to the agreement agree
5	Formal Qualifications	
6	Work & Experience Requirements	
7	Skills Required	Skills in the areas of fundraising, community development, communications, public relations, finance, planning and policy development and information technology. Must reside in area served by the board; demonstrated interest in libraries.
8	Statutory Nomination Requirements	
9	Term of Appointment	Terms for one, two or three years (as determined by the city, town or municipality making the appointment); GIC appointment term is determined by the Governor in Council

10	Remuneration	There is no remuneration for serving on this Board. Members are reimbursed mileage.
11	Anticipated Time Commitments	Meetings held monthly on Mondays, except for July and August in Halifax. (At least 4 meetings/year at minimum)
