

## Board Selection Criteria

Agency, Board or Commission		Pictou-Antigonish Regional Library Board
1	<b>Statute</b>	C. 254, RSNS 1989, the Libraries Act
2	<b>Purpose</b>	To set policy and provide for the operation of the Pictou-Antigonish Regional Library, serving the Towns of Antigonish, New Glasgow, Pictou, Stellarton, Trenton and Westville, and the Municipalities of Antigonish and Pictou. A regional library board is a body corporate.
3	<b>Functions</b>	
4	<b>Composition</b>	1 member appointed by each city, town and municipality that is a party to the agreement; 2 members appointed by the Governor in Council; additional members appointed in such manner and number as the parties to the agreement agree.
5	<b>Formal Qualifications</b>	
6	<b>Work &amp; Experience Requirements</b>	
7	<b>Skills Required</b>	Skills in the areas of fundraising, community development, communications, public relations, finance, planning and policy development, and information technology. Must reside in area served by the board; demonstrated interest in libraries.
8	<b>Statutory/Traditional Nomination Requirements</b>	
9	<b>Term of Appointment</b>	Terms for one, two or three years (as determined by the city, town or municipality making the appointment); GIC appointment term is determined by the Governor in Council.
10	<b>Remuneration</b>	Members are reimbursed mileage.
11	<b>Anticipated Time Commitments</b>	Meetings held 6 times per year on Thursday evenings in Pictou or Antigonish County.
