1	Statute	C.18 of the Acts of 2006, the Midwifery Act
2	Purpose	To regulate the practice of midwifery in order to serve and protect the public.
3	Functions	
4	Composition	The following persons, appointed by the Governor in Council: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 persons recommended by the Association • 1 registered nurse recommended by the College of Registered Nurses • 1 physician recommended by the College of Physicians and Surgeons • up to 3 members of the public

8	Statutory Nomination Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The 3 persons recommended by the Association must be registered or eligible to be registered in a province of Canada as a midwife. • The public members must not be members of a health profession and have shown an interest in serving on the Council.
9	Term of Appointment	Not exceeding 3 years (may be reappointed).
10	Remuneration	Remuneration and expenses as determined by GIC.
11	Anticipated Time Commitments	Council meets quarterly or more frequently, as determined by the Council.
