1	Statute	C. 32 of the Acts of 2000, the Psychologists Act
2	Purpose	Subject to the approval of the Governor in Council, the Board may make regulations respecting a variety of responsibilities and generally, carrying out the intent and purpose of the Act.

4	Composition	Composed of 5 members: 2 registered psychologists appointed for a term of two years; 3 registered psychologists appointed for a term of 3 years; 2 persons appointed (by Governor in Council) for 3 years; The Board appoints one member as Chair and one as Vice-Chair

9	Term of Appointment	3 year term; may be reappointed for two consecutive terms only
