Board Selection Criteria

1	Statute	C. 43 of RSNS, 1989, <i>Boxing Authority Act</i> Boxing Authority Regulations made under Sections 10 and 15 of the <i>Boxing Authority Act</i> , RSNS 1989, c. 43 OIC 2002-579(Dec 17, 2002, effective Jan 18, 2002), NS Reg 155/2002
2	Purpose	To supervise and regulate combat sports in Nova Scotia
3	Functions	Establish and enforce uniform rules for the conduct of boxing; provide for licensing of all persons engaged in or connected with the presentation of boxing contests or exhibitions; provide for and enforce proper medical standards and provide medical examinations for boxers and officials as prescribed by regulations.
4	Composition	Not less than 5 nor more than 9 Governor in Council appointments. Recommend a maximum of nine members be maintained. Because the commissions noted in the Act no longer exist, efforts are made to have representatives on the Board from the geographical areas previously represented by these commissions (Halifax, Dartmouth, Pictou, Cape Breton). Governor in Council designates one member as Chair.
5	Formal Qualifications	None
6	Work & Experience Requirements	A genuine interest and background in boxing
7	Skills Required	A genuine interest and background in boxing
8	Statutory Nomination Requirements	None
9	Term of Appointment	Determined by Governor in Council. Recommend each member serve a three year term.

10	Remuneration	<p>Chair: \$45/meeting + expenses; \$2,000 honorarium*</p> <p>Members: \$25/meeting + expenses;</p> <p>Secretary Treasurer: \$35/meeting + expenses; \$1,500 honorarium;</p> <p>Referee in Chief: \$2000 Honorarium + expenses</p> <p>Referee/Judge: expenses only;</p> <p>Medical Advisor: \$40 professional contestant per analysis (once at weigh in, once after match) + \$500 per event</p> <p>Director of Combat Sports: \$15,000 honorarium + expenses</p> <p>*Honorarium is per year for the duration of the term</p>
11	Anticipated Time Commitments	<p>5-10 meetings per year; 2 hours in length; held in Metro Area; should be able to make time commitment</p>
12	Other Notes	<p>Board members who complete their terms, may re-offer with the Governor in Council approval.</p> <p>One of the 5 to 9 members of the Board will be Vice Chair and elected by the Board members. One of the 5 to 9 members of the Board will be Secretary-Treasurer, as determined by the Chair.</p> <p>Other officers required to conduct and manage the affairs of the Authority include Medical Advisor(s), Referee(s) in Chief and Director, Combat Sport. These positions do not comprise the 5 to 9 members of the Board. In some instances, these have been Governor in Council appointments, but GIC appointment is not necessary.</p>
