1	Statute	C. 4 of Acts of 1995-96, the <i>Community Colleges Act</i>
2	Purpose	<p>MINISTERIAL BOARD</p> <p>Responsible for establishing and overseeing the governing policies with respect to the organization, administration, management and operation of the NSCC in accordance with the Act.</p>
3	Functions	Determine policies with respect to the organization, administration and operation of the NSCC. Ensures that the business and affairs of the College are conducted in accordance with the Act as set out under Section 63 (1) of the Act.
4	Composition	<p>2 students of the College elected by the students of the College;</p> <p>1 academic staff member of the College elected by the academic staff members of the College;</p> <p>1 administrative staff member of the College elected by the administrative staff members of the College;</p> <p>1 support staff member of the College elected by the support staff of the College</p> <p>not fewer than 5 and not more than 7 persons nominated by the Minister</p> <p>not fewer than 5 and not more than 7 persons appointed by the Board</p> <p>Chair and Vice-Chair elected by Board</p>
5	Formal Qualifications	
6	Work & Experience Requirements	
7	Skills Required	Ability to commit time and effort to the work of the Board and its committees; knowledge of and/or strong evidence of interest in the College and its role in enhancing the economic and social well-being of the Province by meeting the occupational training requirements of the population and the labour market of the Province.

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8	Statutory Nomination Requirements	See "Composition" above. When making appointments pursuant to clause (1)(f) [not fewer than five and not more than seven persons appointed by the Board], the Board shall appoint members from a list of nominations put forward to the Board by a nominating committee of the Board.
9	Term of Appointment	Students = 1 year terms; others 1-3 year terms. May be reappointed but shall not hold office for more than two consecutive terms
10	Remuneration	expenses only; no per diem permitted.
11	Anticipated Time Commitments	At least 4 meetings per year; Board determines where and when meetings take place
