

Board Selection Criteria

Agency, Board or Commission		Nova Scotia College of Counselling Therapists
1	Statute	C. 37 of the Acts of 2008, <i>the Counselling Therapists Act</i> .
2	Purpose	The objectives of the Collage are to govern its members in accordance with the Act and regulations, serve and protect the public interest, preserve the integrity of the profession, maintain public confidence in the ability of the profession to regulate itself, establish, develop and promote standards of practice; a code of ethics and continuing-education credits for its members.
3	Functions	The Council shall govern, control and administer the affairs of the Collage.
4	Composition	The board is comprised of: the Chair and Vice-Chair, the Secretary and the Treasurer each of whom must hold a license; no fewer than 3 and no more than 6 members whom holds a license and no fewer than 2 and no more than 3 public representatives appointed by the Governor-in-Council who are not members of the college, and have shown an interest in serving on the board.
5	Formal Qualifications	College appointed members as set out within the by-laws of the College. The public members as appointed by Governor in Council must meet the Board Selection Criteria and are not members of the College, have shown an interest in serving on the Council.
6	Work & Experience Requirements	No specific requirements declared at this time
7	Skills Required	Public members should demonstrate leadership in the community, including volunteer activity and interest in health issues and willing to accept the responsibility of becoming a board member. Ability to work effectively as a member of a team.
8	Statutory/Traditional Nomination Requirements	Governor in Council members must submit a letter of intent and current resume or CV to the Executive Council Office.
9	Term of Appointment	TBD
