3	Functions	The Board shall hold an annual meeting at which it shall appoint examiners, fix times of examination and transact all necessary business.
4	Composition	<p>The Board consists of 7 members:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 3 members appointed by Governor in Council as recommended by the Board, shall be dentists</li> <li>- 1 member appointed by Governor in Council as recommended by the Board, shall be a member of the Hygienists Association;</li> <li>- 1 member appointed by Governor in Council as recommended by the Board, shall be a member of the Assistants Association;</li> <li>- 2 members appointed by Governor in Council shall not be a member of the above associations</li> </ul>
