Agency, Board or Commission		Sherbrooke Restoration Commission
1	<b>Statute</b>	C.425 of the RSNS, 1989, the Sherbrooke Restoration Commission Act
2	<b>Purpose</b>	Oversees the planning of programs within the Sherbrooke Planning Area which will best employ the resources and people of the Village of Sherbrooke and the surrounding district.
3	<b>Functions</b>	Commission is responsible to the Nova Scotia Museum Board of Governors for the proper use and administration of funds granted to the Commission by the Board. Responsibilities include: advising the Minister through the NS Museum Board on the restoration and development of Sherbrooke; responsible for the use and administration of funds, preparation of budgets, planning of programs and operation of the Village.
4	<b>Composition</b>	Executive Director of the NS Museum; member of Council of Municipality of District of St. Mary's; 10 members (recommended to the Minister by the NS Museum Board of Governors) appointed by the Governor in Council
5	<b>Formal Qualifications</b>

7	<b>Skills Required</b>	Demonstrated interest in the community of Sherbrooke Village and its economic development; expressed interest in Sherbrooke Village's role as an educational, tourism, cultural and heritage institution; reside within or near the District of St. Mary's; substantial volunteer/community experience; professional work experience.
8	<b>Statutory/Traditional Nomination Requirements</b>	
9	<b>Term of Appointment</b>	Determined by Governor in Council
10	<b>Remuneration</b>	Expenses only
11	<b>Anticipated Time Commitments</b>	Meet monthly, weekday evenings, in Sherbrooke
