

## Board Selection Criteria

Agency, Board or Commission		Teachers College Foundation Board of Governors
1	Statute	<i>C. 20 of 1998, the Nova Scotia Teachers College Foundation Act</i>
2	Purpose	To administer all scholarships, trusts and awards of the former Nova Scotia Teachers College; solicit money from both private and public sources to maintain and build scholarship, trust and award funds.
3	Functions	Sends applications to Nova Scotia universities offering teacher education programs, receives applications each year, selects recipients.
4	Composition	Not more than 5 Governor in Council appointments; The Minister shall designate one of the members of the Board to be Chair.

6	Work & Experience Requirements	
7	Skills Required	Must be able to attend Foundation meetings; should have a connection with the Nova Scotia Teachers' College community or the potential donor community; an interest in supporting students in teacher education; should have contacts to assist in the role of building scholarship, trust and award funds.
8	Statutory Nomination Requirements	see "Composition" above
9	Term of Appointment	determined by Governor in Council

10	Remuneration	Expenses only

11	Anticipated Time Commitments	One to two meetings (half days) per year.
12	Other Notes	Although the Nova Scotia Teachers College closed in 1994, the funds for scholarships and prizes to students have remained intact and are currently under the control of the Department of Finance.
