Agency, Board or Commission		Université Sainte-Anne Board of Governors
1	Statute	C. 31 of Acts of 2002, <i>Université Sainte-Anne - Collège de l'Acadie Act</i> , and the university by-laws.
2	Purpose	To govern, conduct, manage and control the Université Ste-Anne.
3	Functions	Responsible for the management of the affairs of the Université as prescribed by the relevant legislation.
4	Composition	Ministerial Board: Such number of persons as provided for in the University by-laws; and 2 persons appointed by the Minister. University by-laws provide that the Chair is elected from among the members.
5	Formal Qualifications	None.
6	Work & Experience Requirements	Knowledge of and/or strong evidence of interest in the Université and commitment to its role of enhancing the economic and social well-being of the Acadian and Francophone populations in Nova Scotia.
7	Skills Required	Ability to commit time and effort to the work of the Board and its committees, including external representation; knowledge of and/or strong evidence of interest in the Université; commitment to the values of higher education and the specific role of Université Ste Anne.
8	Statutory Nomination Requirements	None.
9	Term of Appointment	Three years.
10	Remuneration	None.
11	Anticipated Time Commitments	The Board meets four times a year.
