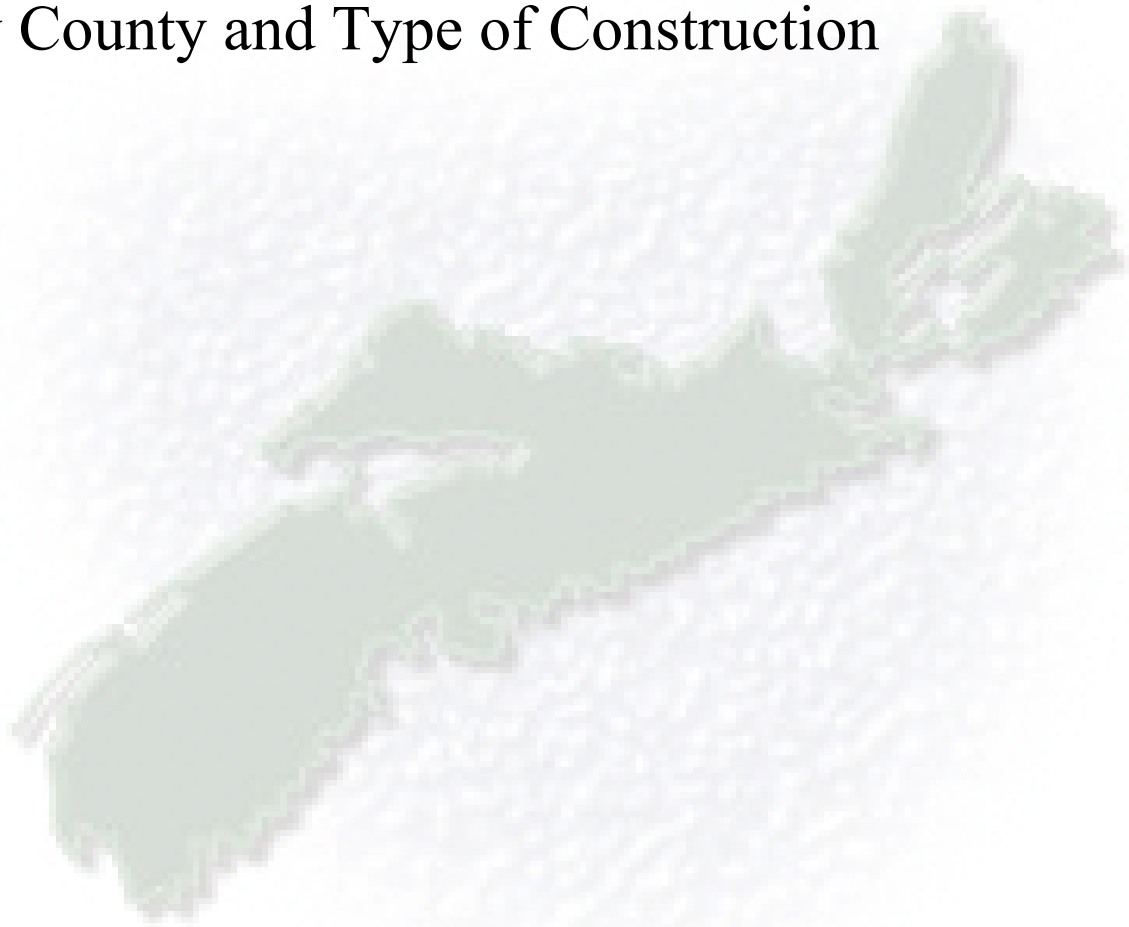


Nova Scotia Construction Activity NOVEMBER 2002

By County and Type of Construction



The *Nova Scotia Construction Activity Report* is published by the Statistics Division of the Nova Scotia Department of Finance three times a year (February, July and November). It provides a summary of projects either presently under construction or contemplated for the future. Information for the listings is obtained from the building permits, C.M.D. Building Reports from CANADATA, Division of Construction Market Data Canada Inc. and news releases.

The listings are by county and cover all known projects of approximately \$1 million or more. Highway and municipal service projects are not usually included unless they represent structures such as bridges. Where possible, the approximate value and/or size of each project is given.

For your convenience, we have enclosed an order form on page (vi), detailing price and purchase options.
