

Nova Scotia Construction Activity November 2004

By County and Type of Construction



The *Nova Scotia Construction Activity Report* is published by the Economics & Statistics Division of the Nova Scotia Department of Finance three times a year (February, July and November). It provides a summary of projects either presently under construction or contemplated for the future. Information for the listings is obtained from the building permits, Reed Construction Data and news releases.

The listings are by county and cover all known projects of approximately \$1 million or more. Highway and municipal service projects are not usually included unless they represent major projects such as bridges or major projects in the area. Where possible, the approximate value and/or size of each project is given.

For your convenience, we have made this report available on our web site free of charge.
