

Decision on Call for Proposals (Reallocation of an Aquaculture Site)

Call for Proposals:

The Nova Scotia Department of Fisheries and Aquaculture (the "Department") issued a call for proposals for the reallocation of an eligible Aquaculture Site. Notice of the call was published on the Department's website. Notice was also provided by email to existing aquaculture licence holders in Nova Scotia.
