MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE COST (MAC) LIST

Effective July 1, 2006, there will no longer be a mark-up included in the MAC price. The MAC will continue to be based on the lowest price in the category (excluding special MACs). Enclosed is a copy of the new Maximum Allowable Cost (MAC) List, **effective July 1, 2006**. Please note that the prices underlined are effective July 1, 2006.

Actual Acquisition Cost (AAC) will be paid for all *new* categories indicated by the black box, until July 1, 2006.
